The Great Fire of London:

The Great Fire of London History learning will teach key events of the Great Fire of London and help to develop an understanding of the ways in which we can find out about the past. There will be opportunity to increase awareness of the past by learning about what London was like in the 17th century. Comparing life in the 17th century to the present day and consider how some problems, such as the lack of an organised fire brigade and the type of buildings, caused the fire to spread. There will then be a focus on how and why some things changed as a result of the fire, in order to be safer. We will begin to learn how historical sources can tell us about what happened in the past and how some sources are more useful than others.
