

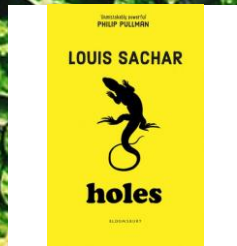
# Summer Two Term Year 6



## English

We will continue our work on portal stories and create our own portal story. In this final term of primary school, children will also have opportunities to fine tune, edit and re-draft previous pieces of work from Year 6, applying all of the skills learnt this year.

## Maths

This term we will focus on consolidation, problem solving and themed projects. These projects will provide an opportunity to revisit many of the skills and curriculum content covered both in Year 6 and the rest of Key Stage 2. The projects have been designed to explore maths in real life contexts, allowing children to see how important maths is in all aspects of life.

## Geography

This term, pupils will learn about the concept of Globalisation. Links will be made with History as we explore how technology and fashion has changed over time and effected the way we communicate. Children will learn about global trade before debating whether globalisation has made the world a better place. Children will carry out an independent project using the chrome books to research and present their findings to showcase their learning in this unit.

## R.E

### Unit 6J: Pentecost:

Children will learn about two stories from the New Testament about the coming of the Holy Spirit. Through their study of the Sacrament of Confirmation they will learn about the Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit and how they are important in the lives of Christians.

### Unit 6L: Celebrating the lives of Mary and the Saints:

In this unit we explore some of the Church's beliefs about the Blessed Virgin Mary and the feasts that are celebrated in her honour. The children will consider why her role in the life of Christ was so important.



## Science

### Animals including Humans

Pupils will continue their learning about animals and humans.

They will make cross curricular links with RHE when learning about the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.

## DT

### Let's Go Fly a Kite

This term, children will explore different kite designs and learn the scientific principles that keep kites aloft. They will be challenged to design and make a kite and investigate whether changing any of the features makes a difference to the success of the kite.



## Music

Music and Drama lessons this term will be focussing on preparing for our end of school Leavers' Assembly which parents are all invited to. Confirmation of dates will be sent out soon.

## French
