Children will build on their work in year 4 to Construct simple series Circuits to find out what happens when they try different Components (switches, bulbs, buzzers and motors. They will also represent a simple Circuit in a diagram.

Renewable Energy.

In this unit Children will learn what renewable energy is and how it Can be used to generate electricity. They also outline the advantages and disadvantages of non-renewable and renewable energy sources.
