Maths

Multiplication and Division B: Factor pairs, multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100, multiplying and dividing 2 and 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number, informal written methods and efficient multiplication.

Length and Perimeter:

Measure in kilometres and metres, perimeter on a grid, perimeter of rectangles and rectilinear shapes, find missing lengths and perimeter of polygons.

Geography

This term we are looking at Migration. We will be looking at what migration is, the causes and effects of migration on migrants and think about the advantages of migration. This will link in with our English topic of focus for this term.

Science

This term we will be looking at Animals including Human with a specific focus on Human Nutrition. In this unit, children will develop their understanding of their personal health and how it is related to human nutrition, dentition and digestion.

DT

This term our focus is on Recycled Art. We will be exploring the different ways materials can be joined and exploring textures and appearances of junk materials, before creating art forms from recycled materials to convey a message.
