

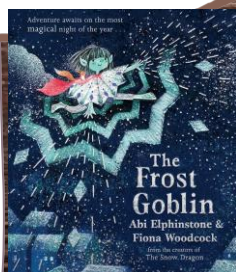
Autumn One in Year X

Maths

Numbers to 1,000 – finishing the unit looking at written calculations and bridging across boundaries.

Unit 3B: Reconciliation

In this unit, children will explore human choices, the consequences of sin, Christ's teaching on forgiveness and the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Unit 3C: Advent

Children in this unit will look at Bible stories of the Annunciation and Visitation. They will explain how Mary and Elizabeth prepared to welcome and recognize Jesus and Christ. They will develop understanding of Advent being a time of preparing for Christmas.

Unit 3D: Christmas

The story of the shepherds provides a focus for the children in this unit to reflect on the birth of Jesus Christ and who he is.

Science

Nutrition:

In this unit, children will be exploring food groups and how they can be used to create a balanced diet. They will compare diets and think about the diets of animals that are not humans.

Rocks:

In this unit, children will be identifying types of rocks, grouping them and testing them before completing a local rock survey.

History

Prehistoric Britain

In this unit, we will be looking at what life was like during the Ice Age and the tools used by early humans initially. We then look at the Stone Age, and what life was like in a settlement, consider why bronze was used for tools and weapons and think about what Skara Brae and other sites can teach us. We end the unit, by thinking about the main differences between the different eras of the Stone Age.
