In English we will be using the fiction book 'The Secret of Black Rock' for our text based lessons. We will be persuasive writers – writing to invite mini-beasts to come and stay at the bug hotel!

Place value:

Numbers to 20, count in 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s, compare and order objects and numbers, recognise tens and ones, partition numbers, write numbers to 100 in words, count in 3s.

Addition and Subtraction:

Bonds to 10 and related facts, add and subtract 1, add 10s, add and subtract across 10.

Animals including humans:

children will begin by looking at animal young and comparing them to their adults. They will look at how animals change as they grow up and be introduced to the life cycles of several varied common animals, including humans. They look in detail at how humans change as they grow older. Children are introduced to the three basic needs of animals for survival (water, food and air). They will apply this knowledge to suggest ways to look after pets.
