
Maths


Creation: God the Creator


This unit lays the foundation for nurturing an awareness of God in their lives.

Physical Development

Children will have plenty of opportunities to develop physically both inside and outside the classroom. They will develop their gross motor skills by throwing and learning to Catch large balls. They will use the outside apparatus to climb, balance and develop control of their body movements in a safe way.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children_will be introduced to Zones of Regulation to support them with self-regulation. Through daily circle times we will be developing our understanding of rules and learning about looking after each otherfollowing our school rules, Be Kind, Be Ready, Be Safe. Children will be encouraged to use language to express their emotions.

Expressive Arts and Design: Art Children will learn how to draw faces and circles.

They will develop sticking skills to make collages of faces and will experiment with colour mixing. Children will use the core texts as a stimulus to make textured owl pictures, beginning using a variety of natural materials.
