A place where everyone is respected and all are deeply valued.

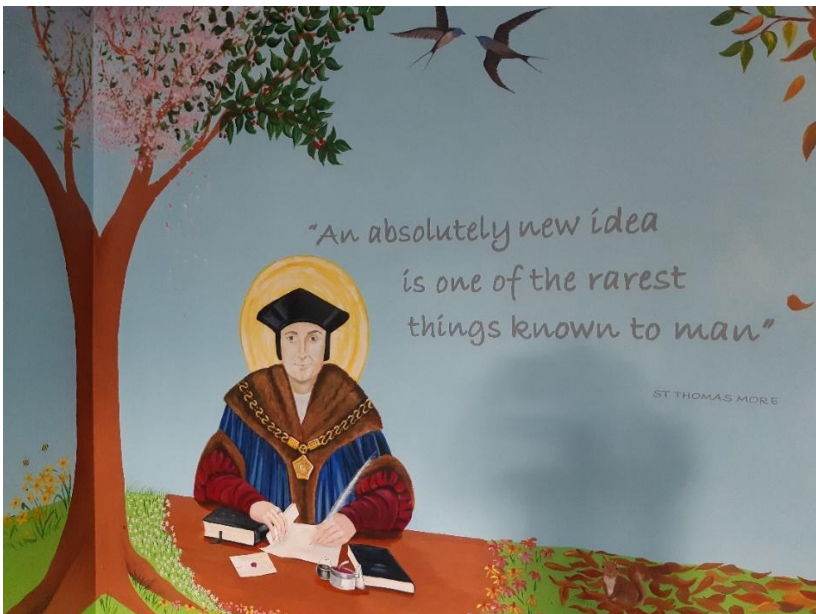
We ask all this through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

the Father

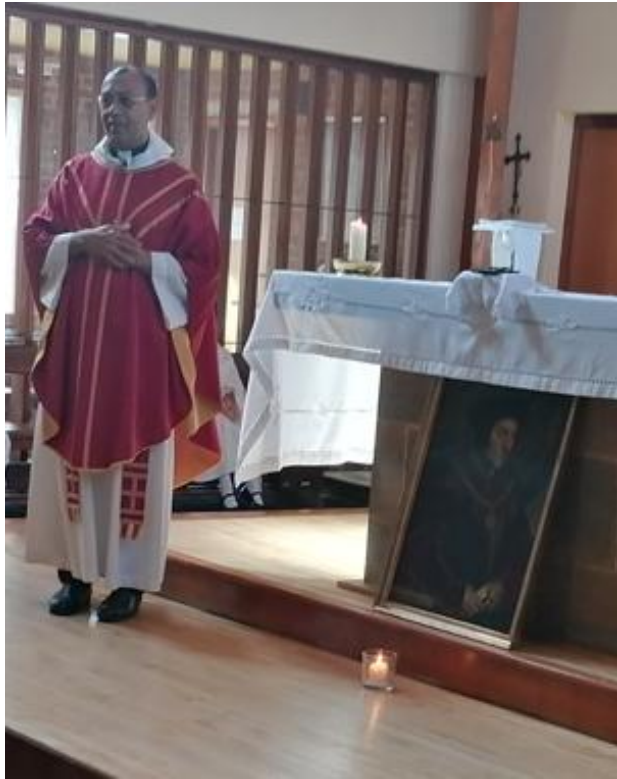


Prayer for Peace
