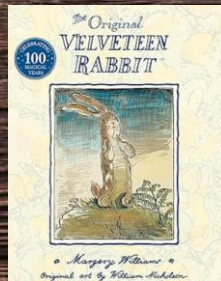
We are reading...

Maths

Number 10-100 (Unit 1 - 4 weeks)

Pupils will learn about the value of different digits and how they relate to each other. They will look at how numbers are positioned on the number line and explain what happens when you add or subtract 10.

Calculations within 20 (Unit 2- 3 Weeks)

Pupils will explore adding and subtracting numbers and use their knowledge to apply skills to different contexts. They will calculate the difference between two amounts.

Mastering Number:

develop conceptual subitising skills as they become more familiar with patterns made by numbers within 10 and understand their composition.

Science

Animals' Needs for Survival

Children will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air).

We will be working scientifically by asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways.

Humans

Children will be able to describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

They will work scientifically by gathering and recording data to help in answering questions.

Branch 1: Creation and Covenant

Creation and Covenant will help the pupils understand and appreciate more deeply why the Bible holds a unique place in the life of the Church by recognising that it is divided into two major parts which together reveal the unity of God's story. Pupils also encounter the idea of covenant more explicitly through Noah's obedience, learning that God desires people to listen, trust and act faithfully. By exploring the moral and relational implications of human choices, pupils deepen their understanding of responsibility and stewardship. Linking stewardship to Baptism helps them recognise that caring for creation and for others is an essential part of Christian discipleship and a faithful response to God's enduring love.

Geography

Seasides and coasts:

Children will learn the geographical features of the seaside, both human and physical. Children will learn about seaside environments; finding out where they are located in the United Kingdom and seaside resorts nearest their own locality using maps and aerial photography - developing their key vocabulary. Children will learn about the similarities and differences between seaside resorts and their own locality. Children develop their geographical skills through fieldwork, inquiry and map-based activities throughout the lessons in this unit.

In our Artwork this term, we will be focusing on the artist Henri Rousseau. We will compare his different pieces of art and create our own work based on the techniques and styles he used.
